About CPHIA

The annual Conference on Public Health in Africa (CPHIA), an initiative of the Africa Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (Africa CDC), offers a unique African-led platform for leaders and scientists across the continent to share the latest in scientific advancements, lessons learnt in the delivery of quality health care, and innovative, evidence-based public health solutions to address Africa's health challenges.

CPHIA 2025 will convene in Durban, South Africa, from 23–25 October 2025, with expected participation from political leaders, health policymakers, innovators and champions in health, entrepreneurs, research scientists, health practitioners, civil representatives and young people. The event, co-convened by Africa CDC and the Republic of South Africa, in collaboration with Bio Africa, will highlight Africa's progress on the global stage under the theme "Moving Towards Self-reliance to Achieve Universal Health Coverage and Health Security in Africa" and organised around eight thematic tracks.

This marks the fourth iteration of the conference, initially held virtually in 2021 and then in-person in 2022 and 2023 in Kigali, Rwanda, and Lusaka, Zambia, respectively. As African countries accelerate the realisation of universal health coverage, annual CPHIAs are helping define how Africa can be more self-reliant in the delivery of quality health care to achieve a healthier, more prosperous Africa – for the continent, and the world.

Exhibitions Application

CPHIA 2023 featured a dynamic and vibrant exhibition space. This year, we're excited to once again offer exhibitors an opportunity to demonstrate their cutting-edge technologies, solutions, and services to a diverse audience of industry professionals, investors, policymakers, and thought leaders. Our 2025 exhibition promises to be engaging, innovative, and impactful, with new features and enhanced interactions.



We invite applications from organisations across all sectors dedicated to uniting public health leaders, fostering collaboration, and paving a new path for health in Africa.

Exhibition organisers are expected to promote the wider conference through their networks and attend CPHIA 2025 in Durban in October 2025.

Exhibitions will be installed by 22 October and remain up until the conclusion of the conference on 25 October. See below for guidelines and details on how to submit an exhibition proposal. Kindly note that all exhibition details will be confirmed after the proposal is approved.

Application Guidelines

Your application to host an exhibition must include the following:

- Proposed exhibition title.
- Description of the proposed exhibition and how it compliments Africa CDC's vision of a safer, healthier and prosperous Africa (**250 words or less**).
- The main goal of the exhibition, such as visibility/brand building, product presentation, advocacy or fundraising, etc. (**100 words or less**).

If the following packages do not meet the needs of your exhibition proposal, please note this in your application; select proposals outside of the package options will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
